Who operates the National Resource Directory?

The National Resource Directory (NRD) is a collaborative partnership among the Departments of Defense, Labor and Veterans Affairs. It contains information from federal, state and local government agencies; Veterans service organizations; nonprofit, faith-based and community organizations; academic institutions and professional associations that provide services and assistance to support the military and Veteran communities.

Why was the National Resource Directory created?

The National Resource Directory was created to serve those who have served our country. The site provides a central place online where wounded warriors, Service Members, Veterans, families and caregivers can obtain comprehensive and up-to-date information about the services and resources available to help them, both nationally and in the communities where they live and work.
